Key Aspects of the Parents' Bill of Rights

The new North Carolina law outlines several rights for parents, many of which reinforce existing policies. While these rights aim to empower parents, Alpha Academy encourages collaboration as a cornerstone of student success.

Some key rights include:

- The right to be informed and involved in your child's education, including updates on your child's academic performance, attendance, and conduct.
- The right to consent or withhold consent for reproductive health and safety education programs.
- The right to access and review books your child checks out from the school library.
- The right to participate in parent-teacher organizations and conferences to support your child's academic and social development.
